Knit Hair Scrunchie Lisa Hennessy KnitPrayShare.com



Supplies

Scrap yarn of your choice Stitch marker to mark beginning of round Elastic hair tie 12-inch circular needles Yarn needle

This is a great way to use up your scrap yarn Depending on yarn weight, CO 60-80 stitches.

Using I Love this Cotton or other WW yarn, I used 12-inch US 8 circular needles and CO 70 stitches, being careful to not twist the stiches when you join it.

Knit in the round for 1 ½ inches for a thinner one and 2 ½ for a thicker one. BO

Since knitting in the round produces the stockinette stitch, I either sew it together showing the garter stitch or the knit stitch.

I have found it easiest to find a book that the hair elastic can go around.



You will use this book to hold your scrunchie shell and elastic. Slip the yarn piece over the book, then slip the elastic on top of it. Seam it together...You are done!
